

Vision For All

Report of the Kenya, Uganda, and Tanzania Mission

July - August 2025

This Vision For All mission, conducted by Anekant Community Center and Aparigrah Foundation, took place in three countries: Kenya (July 10th - 18th, August 5th), Uganda (July 21st - 25th), and Tanzania (July 28th - 30th, August 1st - 3rd). In total, 96,580 vision screenings and 2,006 anemia screenings were performed. Further, 11,183 pairs of eyeglasses were given. This mission would not have been possible without the support of the volunteers, donors, local organizations, well wishers and healthcare professionals who contributed to this mission. Below are the details of this mission's volunteers and sponsors.
